#### POSSIBLE VARIANCES in DATES and DATA

In view of the fact that a wide gap exists between dates and much of the data contained in the Holy Scriptures and those given by secular historians, particularly of very ancient history, it has necessitated a great deal of study and careful thought to be able to judge fairly in such cases, and it is only after the most searching comparisons of numerous authors' works that the dates hereon have been used, which will show at variance with some of the recent writers, who, by the way, fail to agree on a large number of important data.

Another fact which should be well considered is that much attention has been and is being placed on archaeological findings and developments of recent years. Perhaps the most outstanding of all is the Great Pyramid of Gizeh or Cheops, a record in stone, so called, where, it seems, that almost every man can find proof-positive for his form of religion or church, as well as proving from its muffled whisperings the divine calling of his particular nation or people. However, the Author has followed the more conservative writers, and trusts that the student will take all the dates and data which are not well established as being suggestive only.

#### EXPLANATORY

A PLUMB LINE in the center of the Chart marks the Division Line between B.C. and A.D. Facing the chart B.C. is to the right and A.D. to the left. (See center circle.)

CENTURY LINES radiating from the center circle numbered 1 to 40 B.C. and 1 to 20 A.D., and corresponding the line numbers given in the index, thus making desired information easily located.

LINE NUMBERS used in the index do not necessarily refer to dates and are used only for greater convenience in locating desired data.

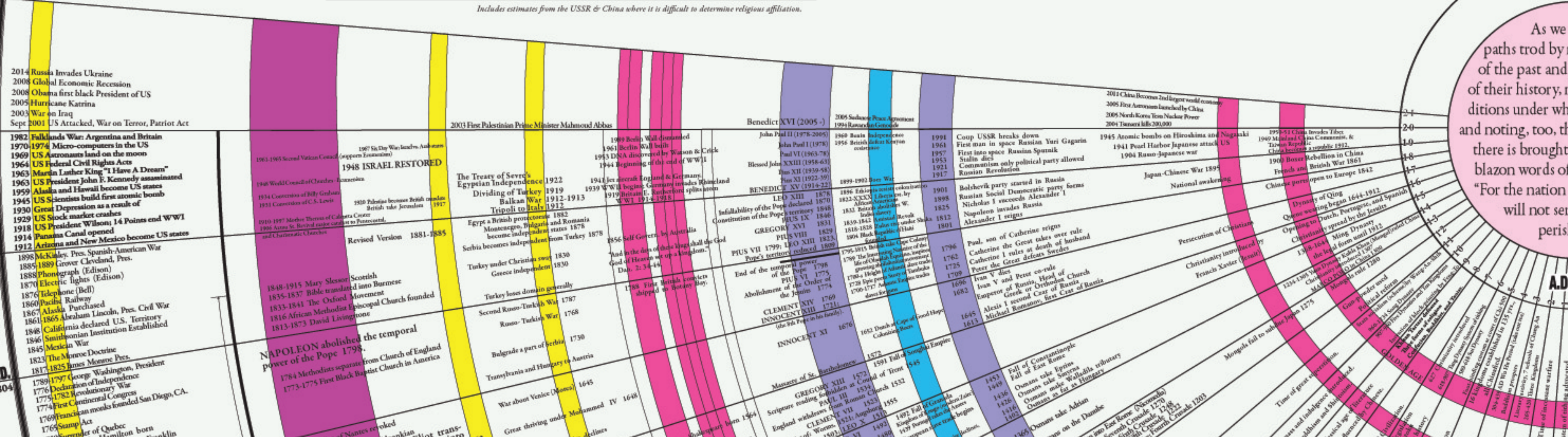
THE INDEX is self-explanatory (See foot note below.)
