Some promises in the Bible were made to a certain person or a special group of people. Those people lived long, long ago and their way of life was probably a lot different to ours. So, are those promises still true for us today?

The Bible is not just a history book that tells us things that happened in the past. God's Word is living and active (see Hebrews 412). God uses His written Word to tell us everything He wants us to know, and that includes personal promises – promises to help us feel safe; to show us part of His plan, and promises give us hope. "For no matter how many promises God has made, they are 'Yes' in Christ" (2 Corinthians 1:20).
