

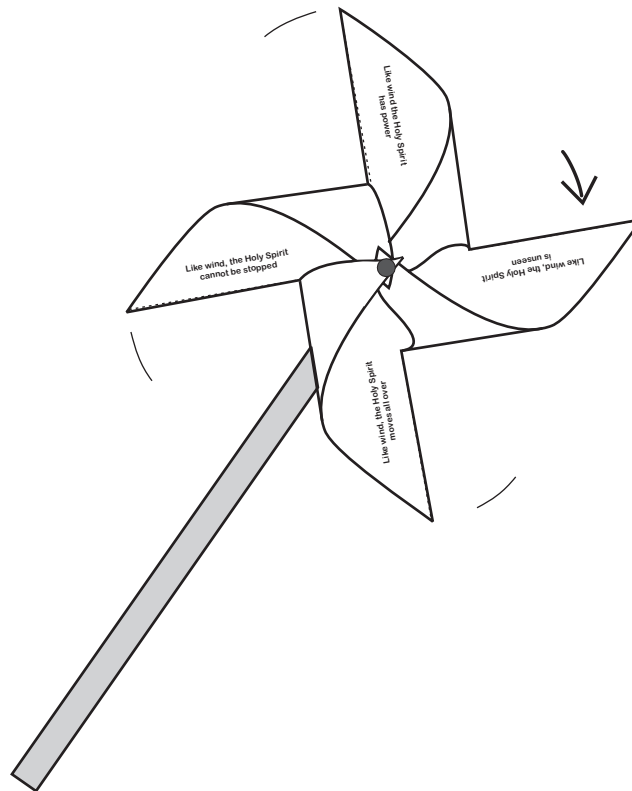
The Holy Spirit

What you will need:

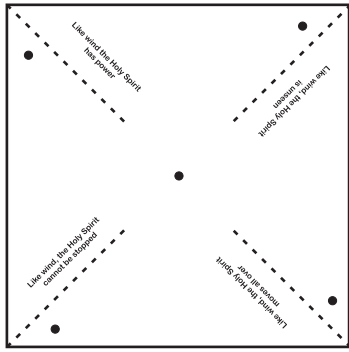
- Printed windmill template (on page 3). Use construction paper/card.
- Push pins
- Beads
- Dowel sticks

Instructions

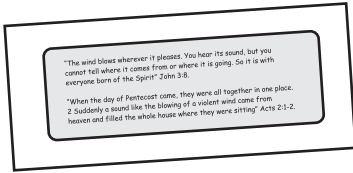
- Cut out the square then cut along the four dotted lines on the square.
- Fold in the corners with dots so that they overlap in the middle.
Hold the corners in place while someone else pushes a push pin through the layers of paper. Use corrugated cardboard as an underlay.
- Place a small bead onto the pin before pushing it into the dowel. (This part should be done by an adult!).
- Ensure that the windmill can spin freely.



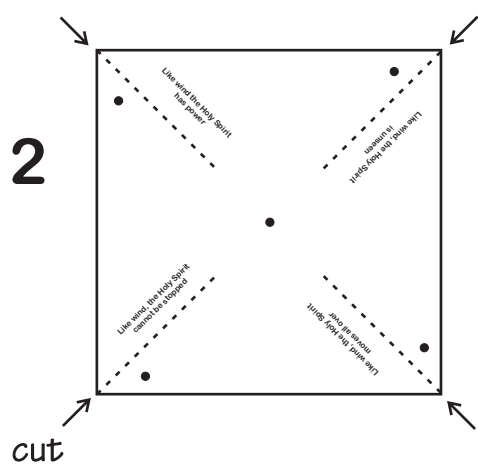

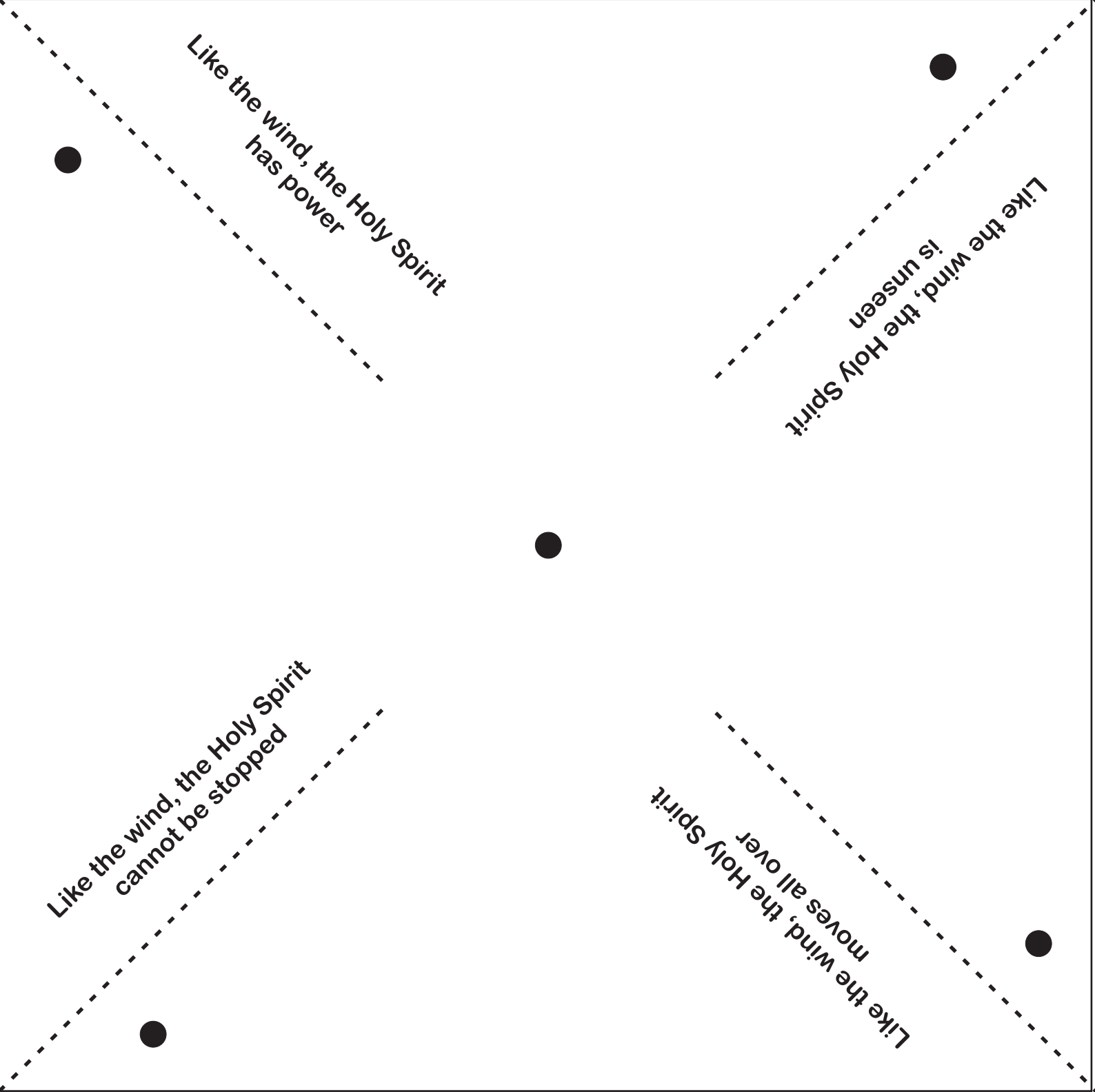
